Dear Howard,

Antiwar Campaign Council Croatia has been working very actively on the problem of conscientious objection and civil service.

Civil Service Committee by the Croatian Ministry of Justice has not stated working yet, because they still haven't got a fourth member, who should be a representative of the interested citizens.

One of our actions are the concerts of spiritual and peace music that are held twice a month. We plan a whole day open air concert next month, that would be connected with the International Conscientious Objection Day.

We would like to organize a round table and a public discussions on that subject. What do you think of this idea? Could it be possible to get the financial help for the organization of these events and other activities from any of funds in Europe? The Center for peace, nonviolence and human rights Zagreb is able to take up the organization of these events.

The political situation is relatively better now for the propagation of this idea. It is important for us to get the practical help in expanding the ~~xx~~ variety of jobs that conscientious objectors can do.

It would also be good to think about the possibility of "exchange", so that some of the people from abroad come to work here. (I think there is some possibility of that in Germany and other.)

I would also like to remind you of the International Forum "Peace and Nonviolence" in Zagreb on 24-25. April (we sent an invitation by fax and over the GreenNet). Shall any of you be coming? Please, do!
